**Harvey Building Products Repositions Manufacturing Resources for Future;
Springfield, MA Manufacturing Plant to Close;
Dartmouth, MA and Londonderry, NH Manufacturing Facilities to Expand**

Waltham, MA (dateline) -- Harvey Building Products, a leading Northeast manufacturer and distributor of high quality windows, doors and patio rooms, today announced plans to reposition its manufacturing facilities by closing its leased facility in Springfield, Massachusetts and transferring production to Harvey-owned, state-of-the-art manufacturing facilities in Dartmouth, Massachusetts and Londonderry, New Hampshire. Harvey will close its leased facility in Springfield, Massachusetts on January 29, 2010, eliminating approximately 100 jobs at that location. Harvey plans to transfer interested employees from its Springfield operation to its facilities in Dartmouth and Londonderry, where approximately 90 jobs will be added in 2010.

In recent years, Harvey Building Products has successfully expanded its product offering with a wider variety of high quality, energy-efficient products. Considerable production capability and capacity is available at Harvey's own state-of-the-art, ISO 9001 certified facilities in Dartmouth and Londonderry, the latter which opened in 2007. As homeowners in the Northeast seek ever-improving energy-efficiency ratings, Harvey has maintained market leadership by optimizing its manufacturing operations.

Harvey Building Products has leased the manufacturing plant in Springfield for the past ten years. A slowdown in the housing market, paired with an upcoming option to renew its lease in June 2010, influenced management's decision to close the Springfield plant. The Harvey Building Products Springfield warehouse, however, will remain in full operation to serve local area contractors and homeowners and allow continued seamless service to valued customers in the greater Springfield area.

“Harvey’s business is changing, with many of our most popular, energy-efficient products already manufactured in Dartmouth and Londonderry. Although this was a difficult decision to make, it was necessary because our Harvey-owned manufacturing facilities have capacity to handle the volume previously produced in Springfield,” said Harvey Building Products President and COO, Alan Marlow. “Harvey is very appreciative of the commitment our Springfield employees have made to the Company over the past several years and we value their contribution. We are hopeful that many will choose to join us at one of our other manufacturing locations.”

The Springfield plant will continue operating at close to current capacity through January 29, 2010. Employees who remain working until the plant closing will receive tenure-based severance packages. Springfield employees will be offered relocation opportunities to comparable positions in Londonderry and Dartmouth as those plants ramp up production. Each of the newer manufacturing plants will add approximately 45 positions in 2010.
